Summary:

There is a divine level of life that we can live only through the discipline of grace. This kind of life requires the presence of the Holy Spirit, who teaches us God's morals and helps us do things that are impossible through our own human ability. He wants to take us to a higher plane that can only be lived on the supernatural level. God will never leave us after He saves us; He stays and works in us until we begin to see positive changes in ourselves. As believers, our dependence on the Holy Spirit to teach us morality and godliness sets us apart from others who depend on their own efforts. Developing and deepening a relationship with the Holy Ghost enables Him to lead and guide us through every situation we encounter, while teaching us the kind of lifestyle that reflects who we are in Christ.

Notes:

- 1. God's salvation is permanent; He now lives in all our lives to perfect and mature us. When we made a decision to believe God, He saved us.
- 2. Our salvation is a gift from Him; we cannot take credit for saving ourselves. Our belief allows God to work in us; the continual work He does in us changes us from the inside out.
- 3. God will continue to mature us for the rest of our lives. He doesn't depend on us to determine the path our lives will take. He can work out His own plans for us without us trying to do it.
- 4. Under the law, the people tried to achieve morality by following rules and regulations but failed. We now have God's own tutor living in us, to help us in this area.
- 5. Everyone on the planet has been given access to God's unmerited, unearned favor. Salvation is a grace gift given to anyone who believes and wants to be saved. Grace only teaches those who have chosen to believe, not the unsaved.
