Summary:

Knowing God's will for our lives gives us focus and direction, but we don't find it by accident; we must be intentional and deliberate in discovering this. Making a commitment in our hearts to do this allows Him to begin specifically guiding and directing us; He'll never let it be a mystery. God wants illumination for us so that we can grasp and comprehend His will. Understanding comes sooner rather than later when we're sensitive enough to His prompting to respond quickly; yielding ourselves to God allows Him to anoint us with our own unique assignment and calling.

Notes:

- 1. Knowing what God has envisioned for our lives saves us from wandering aimlessly. God wants us to understand His plan for our lives, not just to wonder or guess what it could be.
- 2. Becoming more mindful of God and His plans involves letting Him change us from the inside out; the result is that we'll want to do *His* will instead of trying to get Him to bless *our* will.
- 3. God knows us better than we know ourselves; we get better results when we yield to Him.
- 4. To get God's will to come to pass in our lives, we must know that as free moral agents, we have a part to play. He never forces His will on us; however, our success is blocked until we find His will for us, first.
