Summary:

In the spiritual fight with Satan and his demons, our victory hinges on knowing the Word of God well enough to use it as a weapon against a defeated foe. One of the most important strategies is an awareness of what Jesus' blood did for us when He went to the cross. A thorough working knowledge of God's Word on how to defeat the enemy is the important part of our arsenal that keeps us in the winner's circle.

Notes:

- 1. We must align ourselves with other believers and intentionally plead the blood of Jesus.
- 2. A key in our victory over the devil is not neglecting the Christian community; spending time with other believers, both in church and elsewhere, keeps us spiritually strong so that we can repel the enemy's attacks.
- 3. The devil looks for people who are ignorant of what Jesus' blood accomplished; he goes after them and attacks them in their thought lives.
- 4. Part of victory involves specifically declaring what Jesus' blood accomplished: our debt of sin has been paid once and for all, and we're justified, forgiven, and spared from God's wrath.
- 5. We're also healed, cleansed, and have the power to overcome the enemy. We're no longer under the curse of the law, we've been reclaimed from the enemy, and we're no longer strangers to God's covenant of promise.
