- 2. Money is simply a tool; what we must be wary of is the spirit behind it. We can trust God even in the most difficult of times. There will come a time when we cannot trust in anything or anyone else but Him.
- 3. God is well able to take care of us; He wants to be our provider. He is faithful and true. Even when we do not see what He is doing, He is working behind the scenes right now.
- 4. Giving is hard when we are not sure if God can take care of us. This is an issue when people have fallen under mammon's influence. We can trust Jesus to fulfill all the needs we have, including our financial needs. Our trust in Him causes us to be successful.
- 5. Genuine success and prosperity come only through Him. God has a plan for every Christian, and His plans are bigger than our dreams. He drew the blueprint for our lives even before we were born; to see those plans and blueprints come to pass, we must depend on Him.
