Summary:

In order to lead focused lives, we all need guidance to keep us moving in the right direction. When no one is able to show us the way when we get lost, we're still not alone; the Holy Spirit is always by our side, and He promises never to leave or forsake us. When we yield to the Spirit, He tells us everything we need to know to walk in the fullness of God.

Notes:

1. The Holy Ghost will always be faithful and loyal to us; He's a promised gift from God. When we feel alone, He's always walking with us.
2. Speaking in tongues is a grace gift that allows us to pray about things we don't know about. It builds us up in our spirits, bodies, and souls, and enables us to speak directly to God.
3. The three purposes for speaking in tongues are to build up our faith, to draw out the power that the Holy Spirit has put in us, and to access the knowledge He put in our spirits.
4. Speaking in tongues edifies *us*; tongues followed by interpretation edifies the church.
5. When we speak in tongues, we go beyond our own understanding and speak things hidden from our intellectual comprehension.
