Summary:

Life is a series of choices, and our decisions ultimately determine our destination. We can either barge ahead and make our own choices, hoping for the best, or ask for input from the Holy Spirit and let Him lead us. When we allow Him to go ahead of us and we follow, He empowers us to succeed. Speaking and praying in tongues is evidence that we're totally immersed in the Spirit; yielding to Him and accepting this gift elevates our lives from the mundane to the supernatural.

Notes:

- 1. We won't experience the best in life without the Holy Spirit's guidance and direction. Being born again and receiving the baptism of the Holy Spirit are not the same thing; likewise, there is a distinction between baptism by water and baptism by the Spirit.
- 2. A life baptized by the Holy Spirit isn't limited to natural things; He takes us to the supernatural level and empowers us to lead Christian lives.
- 3. Many Christians don't understand the gift of tongues. It didn't die out with the last apostle; it's still valid.
- 4. Speaking in tongues is a supernatural utterance made possible by the Holy Spirit; He empowers us to operate in our God-given authority.
- 5. When we pray in tongues, we pray hidden wisdom known only to God; we aren't limited by our own understanding.
