## Summary:

## Notes:

- 1. Jesus modeled the example of serving others. We succeed by following in His footsteps. How well we lead is tied in to how well we serve. The quality of leadership depends on a willingness to be a servant.
- 2. Choosing not to serve leads to failures and struggles in life. Servanthood matures us. Our goal should be to mature spiritually so that we can do the work of the ministry, which is to build up the body of Christ.
- 3. Refusing to serve opens us up to wrong-thinking.. A self-serving mindset impairs our leadership skills because we are focused on ourselves instead of on others.
- 4. Imitating Christ allows God to bless and elevate us. The world sees Jesus in us. When we choose to be servants, God will exalt us in the same way He did with Jesus.
- 5. A life of servanthood the way Jesus shows us is impossible without the Holy Spirit's help.
