Summary:

God has put individual grace gifts inside each of us; for them to be effective, they need to be used regularly and not remain dormant or flicker out. Similar to the way a breeze can fan a small flame into a blazing fire, we must keep stoking the gifts in us. We must be bold, not shy or timid in using them; this is one way God works in us and through us. Walking in our gifts allows them to develop and mature on the inside of us and keeps our fire burning.

Notes:

- 1. The gifts God gives us can be compared to a fire; we mustn't let that fire die out. We shouldn't be ignorant, misinformed, or unaware of our spiritual gifts.
- 2. It's important to remain aware of the state of our inner fire; this involves looking inside ourselves to examine what's going on in our hearts.
- 3. We have examples of women with grace gifts; we mustn't be afraid to use *our* gifts.
- 4. Prophecy is one of the nine gifts women have received from the Holy Spirit, power is the second gift, and revelation is the third.
- 5. Speaking in tongues helps us to feed the flame in us. Praying in the Spirit adds wood to the fire.
