Uncovering the Spirit of Mammon (Part 3) Creflo Dollar

Summary:

The spirit of mammon is a sneaky, subtle demon that hides from us and tries to disguise itself as the spiritual voice we hear in religion. It always rises up against the Word of God concerning money and trust when the subject is preached, and those possessed by it don't want to hear the message. One tip-off that the spirit of mammon is present is when we verbally confess that we trust God, but pull back from trusting Him with our finances. We're deceived if we believe we can trust Him in the much if we can't trust Him in the area of money, which Jesus called the least. In light of this, we must decide for ourselves whether we're being influenced by God or by mammon.

Notes:

- 1. The spirit of mammon directly opposes everything God teaches.
- 2. How people handle money, and their level of giving, reveals where they place their trust.
- 3. The spirit of mammon will talk to us and tell us things that contradict the Word of God. It will lie to us, but the Spirit of God is faithful and true.
- 4. To avoid falling into bondage to the spirit of mammon, we must know three things: mammon tells us it can protect us from our problems and that money is the solution; it appears to provide things only God can give; and it causes fear by telling us we never have enough money or wealth, regardless of how much we have.
