Summary:

God's favor works in our lives on many different levels, one of which is to provide what we need every day. Our faith, not in what we do but in what Jesus has already done, activates grace to begin working on our behalf. This frees us from constantly striving through our own efforts and enables us to confidently trust in Jesus' finished works. Trusting in His grace matures us and helps us to grow into the person God wants us to be.

Notes:

1. Placing our full trust in Jesus strengthens us and makes us righteous in God's eyes.
2. Jesus *is* grace, and grace gives us strength. We position ourselves to receive the strength that comes through Jesus—as well as everything else that grace has made available to us—by faith in what He did.
3. The Christian lifestyle is all about welcoming Jesus into our lives, not about our striving.
4. We are made righteous by faith in grace. We receive wisdom by faith in Jesus' performance, not in ours. Wisdom is knowing what to do when we do not know what to do; sometimes we simply need to pause before God.
5. We can trust that grace will make us strong, wise, righteous, and redeemed. God living in us, not learning long lists of rules to follow, is what Christianity is all about.
