Summary:

Grace is God's way of loving us and showing us mercy and undeserved favor, simply because we trust in Him and receive Jesus Christ. The key to receiving this unmerited grace is believing in His unconditional, unrestricted love for us. A relationship with God gives us access to the kind of grace that fights for us, protects us, and refuses to let us walk away from Him. When we internalize faith in God's love for us—instead of in our own actions—things we can't take credit for begin happening. Genuine belief in this gives us rest from worry, anxiety, and our own strivings.

Notes:

- Grace is the unmerited, abounding provision of the unrestrained operation of God's infinite love through Jesus Christ on behalf of man, especially those who depend on Him.
- 2. Grace is God's provision for everything we need; this provision is continually increasing for the believer.
- 3. Grace is an aggressive force that will go after us and bring us back to God even when we turn our backs on Him and walk away. It is God's way of insisting on showing us His love and mercy.
- 4. Grace makes, faith takes; however, faith will not work without love. Our faith does not work by how much we love God, but by how much we believe *He* loves *us*. Perfect love is our conviction of this.
