Summary:

To get a clearer picture of God, we need to understand His unearned, undeserved favor toward us. His grace goes far beyond simply forgiving our sins; it's His way of dealing with those who receive Christ. Grace provides assurance, stability, and direction in the lives of believers. It isn't something reserved for when we eventually get to heaven; it immediately begins working in our daily lives the instant we believe and accept Jesus as our Lord and Savior.

Notes:

- 1. To accept Jesus is to accept grace. Without Jesus, we have neither grace nor truth. Grace is Jesus, Himself. Truth and grace are inseparable; grace *is* the truth.
- 2. The undeserved gift of grace works for our benefit to save us, deliver us, and change us. Grace gives us the right to stand before God.
- 3. Under the law, getting blessed was conditional, based on what the people did. Under grace, it's based on what *Jesus* did, and our faith in that.
- 4. Grace provides believers with everything we need for our daily lives on earth.
- 5. There will be an exceedingly great demonstration of grace in the ages to come; it will continue even after we die.
