Summary:

Although He was God in human form, Jesus came to earth and chose to be a humble servant. To genuinely serve others requires that we have the same attitude as Christ, who always put others first. Notes:

- 1. Jesus' life was characterized by the quality of unselfish servanthood. If He hadn't served others, we wouldn't have redemption and reconciliation available to us now.
- 2. Everyone who follows Jesus must be willing to serve, regardless of what others think. Humble servanthood is the mark of spiritual maturity. Negative consequences will arise from selfish service.
- 3. There are hindrances to developing a servanthood mentality, such as the desire for status and the need to feel important, human strategies, a poor concept of our selfworth, and self-centered living.
