Summary:

When we study the issue of money and how it relates to trust, we can't ignore the presence of mammon, which is an evil spirit that's never far from money and tempts us to trust it instead of God. Mammon is the name of the false god of riches in the Old Testament that the people served. Putting anyone or anything in first place instead of God amounts to idolatry. Money is neither righteous nor unrighteous, but when mammon exerts its influence, it opposes everything God does; we must be aware of how this demonic spirit operates so that we can fight it.

Notes:

- 1. We must not trust money; the lying spirit of mammon is trying to influence us. Mammon lies to us and tells us the opposite of what God says.
- 2. The spirit of mammon is the spirit of Satan; he tries to seduce us by convincing us to put money before God and pursue wealth as a primary goal.
- 3. To avoid falling for mammon's lies, we must know God's Word. People have been led to believe money itself is the root of all evil, but that has no biblical backing. God wants us to be blessed financially in the same way that Abraham, Isaac, and Solomon were blessed.
- 4. The spirit of mammon misleads the world; we are to fight against this.
- 5. Adam and Jesus both faced the same temptations; the difference was that Adam was seduced by the spirit of mammon, but Jesus successfully resisted it.
