Summary:

Living godly lives involves depending not on ourselves, but on God and His wisdom, love, and goodness. When we decide to trust God in every area, we receive the humility and godly maturity to acknowledge that **He** is responsible for everything good that happens to us. The believer can't truthfully say he is living godly until he humbly admits that he needs God and accepts His grace. Letting grace teach us how to live a God-first lifestyle keeps us humble and gives us everything we need to thrive.

Notes:

- 1. When we depend on God, His grace changes us and teaches us how to live like Christ.
- 2. Godliness means to regard God and involve Him in everything we do. It involves *voluntary* dependence on Him.
- 3. God is responsible for taking care of the believer and supplying all his needs. Not only does He reinstate us back into Adam's original state before he sinned, but He also makes us into new creations with divine natures.
- 4. Everything in creation automatically depends on Him, except for mankind. Man has been given freedom of choice; choosing to depend on self-effort instead of on God is a sign of pride.
- 5. True humility is giving God, not ourselves, the glory.
