Summary:

Relationships are important to God, especially the relationship between husbands and wives. The traditional mindset is that the man should dominate and rule over the woman. This was never God's intention, and it actually puts pressure on the man to do what he was never intended to do. Jesus was the perfect example of manhood and masculinity; a man will never reach his full potential without a relationship with Him. The world not only misunderstands biblical equality in marriage, but openly rejects it; however, this is necessary for marriages to succeed and for men to be real men.

Notes:

1. Men must understand how Jesus' example of masculinity can apply to their marriages. The Greek translation of "head" means "the source of," and pertains to how something grows and comes into being.
2. Men who let God be their source of nourishment are empowered to nourish, cherish, and love their wives in the same way God loves Jesus and Jesus loves the church.
3. Jesus provided the ultimate example of leadership for men; it is not about being served but about serving others sacrificially.
4. Men who aren't serving others the way Jesus did aren't fully walking in biblical manhood; manhood is all about selflessness. The opposite of following Jesus' example of what it means to be a real man will result in man-law, or what the world calls "toxic masculinity."
