Summary:

To be godly is to put God first and regard Him above everything else. The base of a godly lifestyle is to voluntarily live a life which is totally dependent on God. Grace is inextricably linked to Jesus Christ because He **is** grace in human form. It is therefore impossible to live godly without Jesus. We must depend not only on God's power but also on His wisdom, which is far greater than ours.

Notes:

- 1. Jesus is grace. He's the one who teaches us godliness and total dependence on God.
- 2. Grace empowers the believer to reject worldly lifestyles and put God first.
- 3. God is always faithful; He always keeps His promises. We can trust in His wisdom.
- 4. It's important not to have more faith in our own doings and our own wisdom than in God's wisdom.
- 5. There's a good reason why He allows us to go through our present situation, even if we don't see it at the moment. God often uses situations to manifest His glory because there's a greater purpose which He will reveal later.
