

## Don't Forget God

### Summary:

*Remembering someone indicates how much we value and respect them; likewise, forgetting them indicates a lack of consideration and regard for them. This is especially true when it comes to a relationship with God. Forgetting Him is a sign of pride, but regarding Him and giving Him the credit for our successes is a sign of humility; simply depending on God, without all of the empty works the world exalts, positions us to receive blessings from Him.*

### Notes:

1. Ungodliness is a disregard for God; grace teaches us to avoid ungodliness and to develop a godly lifestyle. Neglecting God and failing to take Him into account blocks any type of real success.
2. God's grace is what teaches us humility; humility is a by-product of relying on God that causes us to credit Him for our blessings. God wants us to depend on Him for everything.
3. God has His own way of dealing with human pride; when we inspect our own attitudes and let Him call attention to our issues, we have to humbly admit His work in our lives in the same way that David did.
4. The natural man is prideful; humility prevents us from boasting in our own achievements.
5. Faith is designed to take possession of what grace has made available; faith is a simple dependence on God. If God's blessing is a reward for good behavior, then we can take the credit for it; however, if it's a gift, then *Jesus* gets the credit.
