Summary:

*As born-again believers, what we confess with our mouths is tremendously powerful. Most Christians are defeated in life because they believe and confess the wrong things. We have the same authority that God, Himself, has. Just like Him, we've been authorized to bring things to pass by what we say. Right-thinking and the willingness to declare what we believe, is crucial; we run into trouble when we speak things we **don't** believe.*

Notes:

1. Our words are more powerful than we realize; therefore, we must be careful what we say. Faith-filled words will get us where we need to go, but fear-filled words will defeat us.
2. Faith in the right things—and the willingness to confess that faith—removes all limitations; saying what we believe triggers results.
3. Our speech has an impact on the direction of our lives; we must speak God's Word.
4. Words are spiritual containers carrying either faith or fear. The power to bring either success or failure into our lives lies in our mouths; therefore, we must confess victory in the face of defeat, and abundance in the face of lack and insufficiency.
