Summary:

The prevailing mindset with most people is that it is fine to listen to the Word, but we need to do something to accompany it. However, God's Word stands out as the only thing we need; if we have godly wisdom, whatever we do will succeed. The truth is that there is nothing greater or more powerful than the Word; after thousands of years, it still applies to us and remains relevant to our lives.

Notes:

- 1. We can either focus on God's Word or get distracted by everything else going on. Whatever we attend to the most will be the harvest that shows up in our lives.
- 2. The Word always produces a good harvest. However, it must be planted in good soil. We must not come up with excuses not to get in the Word. It is alive, and it *always* works.
- 3. The world is a noisy, distracting place. We must take care to keep our priorities straight. We should consider all the issues in our lives in light of what God says about them. His Word brings power and favor into operation on our behalf.
- 4. God's Word brings us peace. *Our* part in the process is to believe and stay at rest. The authenticity of our belief is determined by whether or not we have entered into rest. When we are at rest, we cease to labor.
