Summary:

- 3. There are seven reasons why heaven should be so precious to believers. Our redeemer is in heaven, our relationships are in heaven, our inheritance is waiting for us there, our residence is in heaven, our reward is in heaven, our riches are in heaven, and our reservation is in heaven.
