Summary:

Notes:

- 1. There's power in remembering what God did for us in the past, and thanking Him for it. We don't give thanks *for* everything, but *in* everything; no matter what happens, we can continually appreciate God for His wonderful acts.
- 2. Jesus understood the power of thanksgiving; He used it as a tool to bring about supernatural results and a solution to every circumstance.
- 3. When we give thanks, all of heaven is on our side; thanksgiving works in our favor. In his lifetime, David never lost a battle. He always intentionally gave thanks to God. David was consistently victorious because the supernatural was always at work in his favor.
- 4. The three benefits that come from thanksgiving are that It brings down the presence of God, it brings increase and multiplication, and it destroys the "prayer request" mentality.
- 5. A life of praising God allows us to enjoy His presence at all times, but a life of complaining and murmuring destroys us. Giving thanks brings an increase of love, promotion, mercy, and grace.
