## Summary:

Because we are all human, we are all acquainted with guilt. A guilty conscience robs us of our peace, but this is not God's will for us. The finished works of Jesus enable us to deal with this emotion; His blood is the answer to our sin and guilt. Faith that God is greater than our guilty feelings gives us a clear conscience.

## Notes:

- 1. Guilt is a product of the mind; it occurs when a person realizes they have violated moral, religious, or ethical standards. Guilt decreases our feelings of personal worth.
- 2. When we do something we know is wrong, we can expect our conscience to bother us. Guilt attacks our conscience in multiple ways; sometimes we even make *ourselves* feel guilty.
- 3. Sin gives us a guilty conscience. It causes us to think God is angry with us; however, He has chosen to forgive us and show us mercy. Jesus Christ rescues us from guilt and self-condemnation.
- 4. God is a game-changer; when He shows up in our lives, He transforms things. He changes bad to good, and replaces our guilty conscience with an awareness of our righteousness.
- 5. When we are in Christ, we can forgive ourselves because God has already forgiven us. God has already dealt with our sin. Therefore, we must not let *it* deal with *us* by bringing back a guilty conscience. Guilt will wreck our lives.
