Summary:

*The world we live in doesn't believe in things that are not actively preached in church, including the existence of hell; however, it's a very real place. With this in mind, the final destination of people who don't believe that God and the devil even exist is completely different than for born-again believers. Hell was created for Satan and his angels, not for mankind. It's the consequence for deciding to reject God's forgiveness and Jesus as the final sacrifice for sin; our eternal destiny rests on the choice we make.*

Notes:

1. Most people believe in heaven, and that they will go there when they die; however, although some people believe in hell, most of them don't believe they will go there after death.
2. Hell is permanent, there's no leaving it. It's not an imaginary place; people in hell are fully conscious and aware of where they are.
3. The final destination is horrifying for those who reject Jesus Christ as God's forgiveness. Disbelief in Jesus Christ is what will condemn a person; those who choose not to receive Him will find out too late the consequences of their decision.
4. God does everything He can to keep us out of hell; however, He has also given us the ability to decide for ourselves where we will go after death.
