Summary:

Believers are in a spiritual battle with Satan, who is constantly attacking our minds. Our thoughts determine the course of our lives; we therefore must be aware of what we think. If we don't have an organized system of thought, we'll always be at the mercy of those who do. We succeed only when we allow the Word and the Holy Spirit to govern our thought lives.

Notes:

1. We have authority over our thoughts; we must use this authority wisely. Every issue we face is based in our thinking; in light of that, we must examine ourselves to determine our mindset.
2. God gives us specific directions as to what to think on; a Christian's mind should be tamed according to God's Word, not according to the flesh.
3. Thinking about the things of the spirit, not the things of the world, gives us success. We must put our minds under subjection to God's Word, not to our physical senses.
4. Spiritual-mindedness is a mind that has been shaped by the Word and by the Holy Spirit.
5. After being born again, the most important thing a believer can do is to renew their mind according to God's Word.
